

PtHANM 2010 GENERAL SHOW RULES

SHOW MANAGEMENT WILL HAVE FINAL SAY ON SHOW RULES 2010 PTHA NATIONAL RULES APPLY TO ALL CLASSES

APPROVED PINTO/ALL BREED SHOWS FOR 2010

APRIL 18 (1 JUDGE) - BOSQUE FARMS RODEO ARENA
MAY 15-16 (3 JUDGES) EXPO NM (NM STATE FAIRGROUNDS)
AUGUST 1 (2 JUDGES) - BERNALILLO COUNTY SHERIFF'S POSSE

1. "All Pinto exhibitors and Pinto Owners must be current National PtHA members to show at a PtHA approved show". P. 49 Rule D3 Items A and B of 2010 PTHA National Rulebook. You may purchase a membership at the show.
2. For safety reasons, helmets are required when riding English.
3. No tab will be run at the show office without a signed check. All Fees (except Insurance & Jackpot) are per judge. Jubilee Fees will differ.
4. All protests must be presented in writing with a \$100.00 check to the Show Manager.
5. If the protest cannot be resolved at local level then it will be taken to PtHA and their rules will apply.
6. An exhibitor who submits insufficient funds, closed account, or otherwise invalid check to the Pinto Horse Association of New Mexico will be charged \$35.00 for each invalid check.
7. Show Management reserves the right to cancel, combine, or split classes as necessary, or if warranted by the number of entries.
8. Refunds given only if Show Management cancels class(es).
9. Two-minute gate will be strictly enforced. Time will begin when judges' cards are turned in for the previous class. For individual work classes exhibitors must be in hand, in order-of-go, with only a one-minute gate. If you have a tack change, please notify paddock master.
10. All Pinto horses must have a copy of their registration papers on file with our show office. Owners/lease holders and exhibitors must bring a copy of their current Pinto National membership cards, including Amateur status, and lease papers, if applicable, to be left with the show office. Once your papers are filed with the show office you need not bring them again.
11. PtHANM Point system-----
 - First place horse will earn one (1) point for each horse in the class, not to exceed 6 points (i.e. 6 or more horses - 1st=6, 2nd=5, 3rd=4, 4th=3, 5th=2 and 6th=1).
 - In case of ties, the number of 1st places counted, then the number of 2nds, 3rds, etc. If it is not resolved at that point then the number of horses beat.
12. Pinto Youth will show in the 18 & under age group. These points will be separated into 13 & under and 14-18 age groups for Daily Show High Point and Year End Overall High Point.
13. All breed classes (except as noted below) will allow humane training devices, but may be penalized at judge's discretion.

Training devices will NOT be allowed at the May 15-16 Jubilee Show in All Breed Classes.
14. All breed Youth will show in the 18 & under age group. These points will be separated into 13 & under and 14-18 age groups for Daily Show High Point and Year End Overall High Point.
15. Jackpot Classes are a \$10.00 cash entry fee/class in additional to the regular fee. There are no gate entries and you must pay and enter 3 classes in advance in the horse show office.
16. Miniature horses must be 38" or under. Ponies must be over 38" and under 56" inclusive.
17. Incomplete entry form may result in a loss of PtHA Points.

DAILY SHOW HIGH POINT AWARDS

- Each owner & handler (**regardless of division**) must be a current member of PtHANM to qualify for an award. Points will start to count when current year membership is paid in full.
- Pinto Horse, and All Breed exhibitors must show in at least 5 classes in their respective division at each approved show to qualify for Daily Show High Points in that division.
- Pinto Pony and Pinto Mini must show in at least 3 classes in their respective division at each approved show to qualify for Daily Show High Points in that division.
- All Breed Pony/Mini must show in at least 2 classes in their respective division at each approved show to qualify for Daily Show High Points in that division.
- To qualify for an individual **DAILY SHOW HIGH POINT AWARD**, each entry will be eligible in the following categories:
 - **PINTO:**
 - 13/U 14/18
 - Open Amateur
 - Pony Mini
 - **ALL BREED:**
 - 13/U 14/18
 - Open Pony/Mini

PtHANM YEAR END AWARDS

- An entry or team is defined as **one horse/one rider (handler or owner)**.
- Multiple exhibitors may exhibit open division horses.
- Each owner & handler (**regardless of division**) must be a current member of PtHANM to qualify for an award. Points will start to count when current year membership is paid in full.

WORK REQUIREMENT for YEAR END AWARDS

- Each entry must work, or have someone work for them, an equivalent of one day at a PtHANM approved show,
- or 1 day at a training show plus ½ day at an approved show,
- or pay a \$100.00 work fee. (If you pay the \$100.00 work fee, it must be paid before your points will count.)
- Working only at Training shows will not satisfy your work requirement
- The following full day positions will be paid positions at the approved shows.

If you work and are paid for a position, you must still work (non-paid) or have someone work for you in order to be eligible for Year End Awards.

Donating your pay back to the club will satisfy your work requirement for Year End Awards.

To qualify for a Year End Overall or Year End Class Award:

- Pinto Horses must show under at least 3 of 6 judges,
Pinto Pony/Mini must show under at least 3 of 6 judges,
All breed must show under at least 3 of 6 judges, at the PtHANM approved shows.
- Pinto Horses must show in that class under at least 3 of 6 judges,
- Pinto Pony/Mini must show in that class under at least 3 of 6 judges,
- All Breed must be show in that class under at least 3 of 6 judges, at the PtHANM approved shows.
- Overall Year End High Point Awards will be awarded to:
 - Pinto Youth 13/U and 14/18
 - Pinto Open Horse
 - Pinto Amateur
 - Pinto Mini
 - Pinto Pony
 - All Breed Youth 13/U and 14/18
 - All Breed Open Horse
- Overall Year End Class High Point Awards will be awarded in the following divisions:
 - Pinto Youth 13/U and 14/18
 - Pinto Open Horse
 - Pinto Amateur
 - Pinto Mini
 - Pinto Pony
 - All Breed Youth 13/U and 14/18
 - All Breed Open Horse

For Year End Class High Points, if you are the Overall Year End High Point in a division you will not earn Class High Point awards in that same division.

In the event the Jubilee Show class list conflicts with other local shows class list, consideration will be taken as to requirements for Year End Awards.

NEW MEXICO STATE FAIR PHIL SANDUSKY TRAVELING AWARDS ELIGIBILITY

- There is one award presented to the Pinto Amateur and one presented to the Pinto Open Horse at the Pinto Show at the New Mexico State Fair each year. This traveling award shall be returned to the PTHANM Board the following year prior to the New Mexico State Fair Pinto Show with the previous year winner's name/year (at the expense of the winner) engraved on the award.
- Must be current PtHANM member.
- Must have shown under at least 3 of 6 judges at PtHANM approved shows during current year, with at least 5 classes in the respective division at each show.
- **Open and Amateur** must show in color class at New Mexico State Fair.
- Points will not count in the color class, but exhibitor or horse will be noted as entered, therefore qualified for their respective award. Halter and performance classes with the highest number of points earned, wins, with the exception of color class.
