Training devices will NOT be allowed at this Jubilee Show in any class, including All Breed classes. Proper show attire is required in all classes, grooms in arena must be in proper attire.

All Breed Walk/Trot exhibitors may not cross enter any other class (All Breed or Pinto) that may require a canter or a lope. Exception is Halter/Showmanship at Halter
